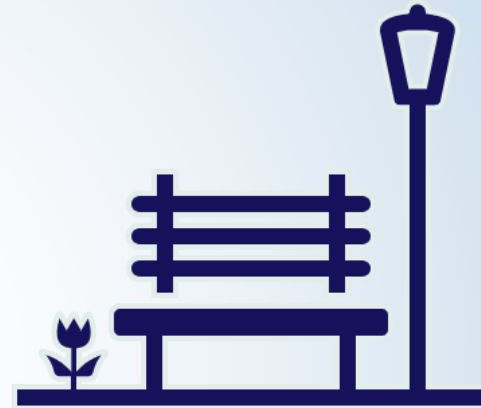

Replaced faded No Parking/Fire Lane signs In Hopewell Valley, Saddlebrook, Thornton Grove, and Canterbury Subdivisions and on Main Roads

Patched potholes throughout the township

Ditched on Sibcy and Schlottman Roads, Sycamore Street, Sunny Lane and Overbrook Avenue

Building Maintenance:
Removed center island, replaced damaged ceiling tiles, repaired water leak in Training Room and sealed all roof vents at Administration Building.

Park & Cemetery Updates



Laid out and painted parking lot areas at Mounts Park; cut out sod and installed gravel for new parking lot

Removed fence around Community Garden and cleaned up trash

Replaced 15" culvert across driveway at Marr Park; ditched and installed rip rap

Tore down walls on old house at Marr Park

Laid out graves and updated missing and wrong information on Deeds file for Maineville and Murdoch Cemeteries

Repaired electric to shelters and installed new lights, repaired flag lights and trimmed trees along walk trail at Testerman Park

Replaced damaged and broken fence rails at the Dog Park

Cleaned up debris from receding water along big lake at Mounts Park

Filled potholes with rotomill on driveway at Mounts Park

Poured concrete foundations at Maineville and Murdoch Cemeteries

Performed 1 burials at Maineville Cemetery
