HTFR: Revised 08/26/2019

Effective immediately, no Hamilton Township Fire Inspector shall conduct any inspection of new fire protection systems or any acceptance test on any fire protection system without proper documentation of an installers (individual) current State of Ohio license through the Ohio Fire Marshal's office, as referenced in the current OFC sections 915.2 and 915.11. Each inspector shall ask to see a current State of Ohio license prior to conducting the test(s) or inspection. The name of the installer, state license number, and expiration date shall be recorded in the inspectors report. The State of Ohio license must be applicable for the type of fire protection system being installed, (i.e. Underground NFPA 24, Aboveground NFPA 13, Fire Alarm Systems NFPA 72). We will no longer accept faxed copies of the installer's state license. If the installer does not have a current Installer's State of Ohio license on his/her person at the time of the test/inspection, the appointment must be rescheduled.
