Officers will patrol assigned areas, respond to calls for service, conduct investigations, and engage with the community to promote safety and trust.

Responsibilities include:

- Patrol assigned areas to prevent and detect criminal activity.
- Respond to emergency and non-emergency calls for service.
- Enforce state laws and local ordinances.
- Prepare accurate and detailed reports and maintain proper documentation.
- Testify in court proceedings as required.
- Provide assistance, information, and education to the public.
- Participate in Police initiatives, community events, and special assignments when needed.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 21 years of age.
- Must possess a valid Ohio driver's license and maintain an acceptable driving record.
- Must possess a current Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) certification
 or be able to obtain certification prior to appointment.
- Must pass a comprehensive background investigation, psychological evaluation, Computer Voice Stress Analysis (CVSA), Motor Vehicle Record check (MVR), and drug screening.
- Ability to work various shifts, including nights, weekends, and holidays.
- Demonstrated commitment to community engagement and problem-solving policing strategies.
- Strong interpersonal, communication, and decision-making skills.
